### MCSO PRESS RELEASE August 4, 2009

Warren Steed Jeffs, 53, of Hilldale, Utah, has been incarcerated since February 26, 2008, in the Mohave County Jail in Kingman, Arizona.

On Friday, July 31, 2009, medical staff at the Mohave County Jail documented that Mr. Jeffs refused to eat; therefore, force feeding was initiated that morning.

On Tuesday (8/4) morning the Sheriff's Office was informed that Mr. Jeffs was eating again. Since then, it was learned that Mr. Jeffs had been eating on his own up until Monday (8/3) night. Medical staff has had to commence the force feeding as of Tuesday (8/4) morning.

Mr. Jeffs is closely being watched 24 hours a day.

### **SEARCH AND RESCUE – DOLAN SPRINGS**

Mohave County Sheriff's Search and Rescue Units were deployed Monday (8/3) evening due to a missing person. Approximately 8:15 p.m., the reporting party said that her husband, Leonard Goldstein, 66, of Dolan Springs, left walking from their residence in the 18100 block of Lomila Drive late Monday (8/3) afternoon and he has not returned. At about 8:30 p.m., Search and Rescue Volunteer Units from Lake Havasu City, Bullhead City and Kingman responded and immediately began a ground search. Kingman Air Rescue Ranger, Arizona Department of Public Safety, responded and conducted an aerial search. Tuesday (8/4) morning, at about 7:00 a.m., Search and Rescue Units located Goldstein approximately 4 miles northwest of his residence in the desert. Lake Mohave Ranchos Fire Department personnel responded and transported Goldstein to Kingman Regional Medical Center.
