

**Finality:** This Decision and Order is final unless a party files a written Motion for Rehearing or Review of the Decision and Order, specifying the particular grounds therefore, pursuant to A.A.C. R13-4-118(E) and (F) and A.R.S. § 41-1092.09. The motion must be received at the Board's office within thirty-five days after the Decision and Order is mailed or

1 within thirty days after it is personally served, whichever is sooner. A party's failure to file a  
2 timely Motion for Rehearing or Review at the Board's office has the effect of prohibiting the  
3 party from seeking judicial review of the Decision and Order.
